## BOARDING POLICY

- All dogs must have current immunizations against Rabies, Distemper, Parvovirus, and Bordetella.
- All cats must have current immunizations against Rabies, Feline Distemper, Rhinotracheitis, and Calicivirus. (Leukemia vaccine is optional and is based on the lifestyle of the pet)
- All animals must be up to date on prevention while boarding at our facility. This includes heartworm/intestinal/external parasites (fleas & ticks) for dogs and intestinal/external parasites for cats. Animals not up to date will be treated with a capstar and will have a fecal examination done at owners' expense, even if the fecal is current. Dewormer will be administered as needed based on test results. This is for the protection of all pets in our care.
- We require all boarding animals to have a fecal examination for intestinal parasites within the last 6 months if current on preventions.
- A bath is required on the day of dismissal and a complimentary 10% discount per night will be applied to the bath charge only.
- All clients are required to read and sign the boarding admitting form. Be sure to include an emergency number and or contact if you will not be available while your pet is boarding at our facility.
- Animals will be admitted & discharged **ONLY** during regular office hours. Sunday pickup is available excluding holiday weekends between the hours of 5:30 - 6:30pm only and must be **PREPAID**.
- Any animal that requires emergency or immediate veterinary attention will receive it at our discretion, and at the owner's expense. We will attempt to contact the owner before any treatment is done. No sick animals will remain in our hospital without treatment. Owners are welcome to pick them up immediately if services are declined.
- We will provide your pet with adequate bedding and dishes. Pets are fed Hills brand Science Diet sensitive stomach dry food. It is unnecessary to bring any items other than medications or special diets. Please be aware that any personal items left with your pet may be damaged or lost so please leave them at your discretion.
- Please let us know if you have any questions or concerns. Your satisfaction and your pet's well-being are our primary concern.
